Case Qualifications

- No upfront deposits are required until the parties set the arbitration date
- No cancellation fees are assessed if the case is settled prior to the arbitration date, unless the ADR Systems' neutral has already done work on the case
- We will help parties tailor all aspects of their arbitration, including neutral arbitrator selection, governing rules, discovery and evidentiary hearing

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
